



# How to Change Password for Nessus Cloud

*(Note: Only an Administrator account has the ability to update the password for a non-administrator Nessus Cloud account.)*


Log in to the Nessus Cloud account.


Click the username displayed at the top right of the screen.




From the drop-down menu, select "Settings".




Click "Accounts".




Click "Users".




Click the email address listed under the name column.




Click "Change Password".
